MONDAYS

7-week session – 4/19/10 to 6/7/10 (no class on 5/31)

1. MUSICAL THEATRE (NEW CLASS!) - From "The Lion King" to "High School Musical" and more! If your child needs to sing as well as dance, this class is playing your song! GENERAL INFORMATION

- Payment is due in ADVANCE with your completed registration form. Please return your form and payment to the school office **no later than Tuesday, April 13th.**
- **Classes begin Monday, April 19th and end Thursday, June 10th.**
- “No School” and “Noon Dismissal” days have been taken into account in the Enrichment schedule. PLEASE mark your calendars with class dates!
- Classes will be filled on a “first come, first served” basis. Most classes have minimum/maximum enrollment numbers, and may be canceled due to low enrollment or closed to new students if the maximum number is reached. A full refund will be given in this event. *If you are interested in a class, please encourage others to sign up, so that cancellations won't be necessary.*
- Students will be given a one-week “trial period” for Enrichment classes, in which refunds will be granted. **PLEASE NOTE: After the first week, no refunds or prorating will be given.**
- If a class is canceled due to instructor unavailability, it will be rescheduled.
- Most classes are scheduled from 2:45-3:45pm, with a few exceptions. Please refer to Registration Form.
- Children should be picked up at the end of class at the classroom site. Please make sure you pick up your child on time. Your child will be brought to Adeste and charged the hourly Adeste fee if not. If a class site is changed for any reason, we will notify you in advance.
- Most classes are held in the Trepp Center, where there is **no water fountain**. Please send your child to school with an extra drink.
